<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Mass Casualty ID tag <p>1000 units = \$350</p>	<p>Enables MDA Medical Teams to categorize victims in mass casualty scenarios, in order to be able to triage and treat casualties</p>	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Stick Light <p>100 units = \$200</p>	<p>Enables MDA Medical Teams to identify themselves and casualties in darkness to allow for treatment in the dark</p>	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Endotracheal Tube <p>100 units = \$150</p>	<p>Intubations Tube, used to ventilate the patient in critical condition</p>	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Intraosseuse "Gun" <p>10 unit = \$750</p>	<p>When IV access is unavailable, this "gun" shoots a needle into the bone marrow, allowing induction of fluids and medicine into the body system</p>	





<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Alcohol Preps <p>1000 units = \$25</p>	<p>Cleaning and des-infecting the skin before puncturing with a needle</p>	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Chest Decompression Needle <p>10 unit = \$150</p>	<p>Used to decompress air in the injured chest cavity, in critical chest injured patients</p>	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Surgical Blades <p>100 units = \$185</p>	<p>Used to cut sterile equipment, cutting the umbilicus cord etc.</p>	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Life Pack Spare Parts <p>1000 units = \$100</p>	<p>Includes cardiac electrodes (disposable), external pacemaker electrodes (disposable), ECG paper for recording cardiac rhythms</p>	






<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Sterile Syringes in Different Sizes <p>100 units = \$120</p>	<p>Used to inject medicine into the patient</p>	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Gauze Pads <p>1000 units = \$90</p>	<p>Used to absorb and pad wounds</p>	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Scissors • Adhesive tape <p>1000 units = \$500</p>	<p>Used to apply first aid dressing to wounds</p>	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Gauze Rolls <p>1000 units = \$120</p>	<p>Used to cover wounds to avoid infection and further damage to the skin</p>	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Sphygmomanometer & Stethoscope <p>10 units = \$250</p>	<p>Enables to check the patient's blood pressure. Used by all teams – First Responders, E.M.T's, M.I.C.U Paramedics and Physician's</p>	





<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Trauma Cervical Collar <p>10 units = \$150</p>	<p>Used to prevent head movements of trauma patients</p>	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • IV Needles in Different Sizes <p>1000 units = \$900</p>	<p>For the administration of medications and fluids</p>	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Manual Ambu Resuscitator – Adults & Children <p>10 units = \$1200</p>	<p>Apparatus for emergency manual ventilation. Self inflating air bag, valves, face mask and oxygen flow connector. The child size is optimal for ventilation for premature babies, infants and children.</p>	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Oxygen Cylinders, Small Size <p>10 units = \$1000</p>	<p>Portable. For use on all MDA Life Saving Vehicles, First Responders etc.</p>	


<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Oxygen Cylinders Regulators <p>1 unit = \$200</p>	<p>The device regulates the flow of oxygen (liter/minute) that is given to the patient, allows an accurate monitoring of the oxygen given to the patient.</p>	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Laryngoscope Kit <p>1 unit = \$250</p>	<p>Handle and various sized blades for a life saving procedure - Intubation</p>	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> First Aid Dressing <p>1000 units = \$800</p>	<p>used to cover wounds and control bleeding</p>	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Oxygen Masks (all sizes) <p>1000 units = \$1050</p>	<p>Disposable oxygen masks for patients</p>	

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Non Latex Gloves <p>1000 units = \$175</p>	<p>Disposable rubber gloves, used for all medical procedures.</p>	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Trauma ALS Bag <p>1 unit = \$1500</p>	<p>This backpack contains all basic and advanced life support medical equipment. Enables MDA medical personal to administer medical treatment in various situations. The kit contains BLS (Basic life support) and ALS (advanced life support) equipment.</p>	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • IV Fluids <p>1000 units = \$400</p>	<p>IV therapy for regaining loss of body fluids</p>	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Plastic Airway Pharyngeal Device <p>1000 units = \$375</p>	<p>To obtain an open airway in the unconscious patient</p>	

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Ice Pack <p>100 units = \$200</p>	<p>Used to cool wounds, fractures and flesh wounds</p>	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Tourniquet <p>100 units = \$150</p>	<p>Used to control severe bleeding in the extremities.</p>	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Saline Fluid for Injection <p>1000 units = \$380</p>	<p>Physiological fluid Used to dilute medicine and for the flushing of wounds. Also used in inhalation therapy</p>	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Triangular Bandage <p>1000 units = \$450</p>	<p>Used to cover wounds and to immobilize fractures</p>	

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Childbirth Delivery Kit <p>100 units = \$1500</p>	<p>This kit holds all disposable, sterile medical items used in Gynecology emergencies and Baby Deliveries.</p>	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Asherman Chest Seal Bandage <p>10 units = \$200</p>	<p>Used to seal open chest wounds, with a one-way valve</p>	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • PCO₂ Sensor Adaptor <p>1000 units = \$1100</p>	<p>Enables MDA ALS Teams to evaluate the quality of the patients ventilation</p>	 
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Inhalation Mask <p>1000 units = \$1300</p>	<p>Enables inhalation medical therapy for respiratory patients (asthma, smoke inhalation)</p>	

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Facial Mask <p>1000 units = \$760</p>	<p>To be used by both medical teams and patients</p>	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Quick- Trach <p>100 units = \$1,100</p>	<p>This device allows a quick lifesaving surgical procedure to enable direct tracheal ventilation</p>	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Intercostals Drainage Kit <p>10 units = \$500</p>	<p>This kit enables a lifesaving procedure to drain and decompress critical chest injuries</p>	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Contaminated Medical Waste Basket <p>100 units = \$450</p>	<p>Used in all MDA Emergency Medical Vehicles, Blood Services Units</p>
