The Need for a New National Blood Centre



It probably comes as no surprise that Israel has a National Blood Centre to store and distribute the nation's blood supply. It is also not unusual that Israel rests on two active seismic fault lines and is susceptible to earthquakes; California, Mexico and Japan have to live with this reality every day.

So what makes Israel so different that it needs the most secure Blood Centre in the world? Israel is one of the smallest nations in the world. In certain areas, it is only a handful of kilometers wide. This tiny nation is surrounded by enemies from all sides, both nation-states and terrorist networks. Take out your calculator, add it all up, and you're left with a very risky existence, to put it lightly. Consequently, a secure blood supply is one of the most crucial elements in ensuring the continuity of the State of Israel.

Now, more than 30 years after its inauguration, Israel's current National Blood Centre has reached maximum capacity. Collecting 260,000 units of blood annually, the Centre is no longer fit to accommodate

the needs of the growing population, which has grown from 4.1 million in the late 80s, to 8.5 million today. The Centre is also not equipped to withstand the destructive force of a major earthquake, nor is it made to protect against long range weapons and potential biological or chemical warfare. Israel and MDA recognize that these significant strategic challenges can only be addressed through the creation of a new centre.

Thankfully, construction is under way on MDA's new state-of-the-art Marcus National Blood Services Centre (MNBSC), but the job is far from done, and Israel needs our help. In a recent report, MDA Blood Services Director and renowned hematologist, Professor Eilat Shinar, noted:

"Our building is simply no longer secure given the current threats, nor does it comply with earthquake preparedness regulations."



MDA is not a government agency and it depends heavily on private funding from donors around the world to continue operating. The building of the MNBSC is MDA's most ambitious capital project to date. The Centre is expected to cost \$130 million USD and thanks to CMDA, American Friends of MDA, and other friends around the world, over \$100 million has already been raised. This has all been made possible through the generous support of a number of prominent philanthropists, including Bernard Marcus, the founder of Home Depot, who made a transformative gift to name the new facility.

The new Marcus National Blood Services **Centre** will be the central facility where all blood collected in Israel will be processed and distributed to the nation's hospitals, establishing a safe and secure location for Israel's national blood supply. The new



MNBSC is of vital strategic importance to the State of Israel, and its development is strongly endorsed by the highest levels of the Israeli government, including the Prime Minister's Office, Home Front Command (HFC), the Ministry of Defense, and the Ministry of Health. It is urgently needed not only to meet Israel's future blood capacity

needs, but also to withstand external threats from an increasingly emboldened Iran and other enemies of the Jewish state with whom the prospects of war are always imminent.

This unique facility will be the only underground blood centre of its kind in the world, ensuring Israel's blood supply is safe from enemy rocket attacks, and chemical and biological assault. The MNBSC will have the capability to process and store over 500,000 units of blood to meet the future needs of Israel's growing population, which is expected to reach 10 million by 2030. In addition, it will be constructed to conform to current earthquake guidelines, and it is designed with advanced technology and cyber-security to provide for maximum protection against even the most unconventional threats in today's ever evolving political landscape.

As a result of their three-hour visit, the Quints realized, more than ever, the important role Magen David Adom has in saving lives. They also realize the need for a new National Blood Centre is even more imperative than ever!

Raphael also talked about the importance of the International Physicians' Unit, the "7 First Minutes", and the new National Blood Centre that is being constructed underground.

A Powerpoint presentation, "One Country, One Organization, One Message", elicited a lot of discussion. The presentation included the restructuring of the organization into three regions — Eastern, comprising Montreal and Ottawa; Central, comprising all of Ontario except for Ottawa; and Western, comprising Calgary, Edmonton, Winnipeg and, in the future, Vancouver and Victoria. Priorities for 2019 were also discussed. They included a database

update, website content, fundraising, marketing, and an annual CMDA event calendar.

Following a well-deserved lunch break, the afternoon session began with a presentation by CMDA National Executive Director, Sidney Benizri. Entitled "2020 Mega Mission", the proposed mission would take place in the spring of 2020 in honor of MDA's 90th Anniversary and would involve the Friends' Societies worldwide.

The meeting culminated with regional and chapter reports. A great deal of information was provided and a lot was accomplished; however, there is still much work to be done.

After her remarkable presentation, the audience was treated to a world-class entertainer who put on a dazzling show. Oz Pearlman, a mentalist who has been seen on many TV programs and who has received great accolades from the New York Times, The Wall Street Journal and Forbes, among others, appeared to be reading peoples' minds. People chosen at random from the audience participated in his act and were as surprised as members of the audience at how he seemed to know what they were thinking. Other events that have taken place include a Volunteer Awareness Evening with more than 50 people in attendance, including speakers Fanny Wedro, a generous CMDA donor. They explained the importance of supporting Magen David Adom through donations of essential medical equipment and supplies, which will enable MDA to continue to save lives.
