Electric Vehicles now part of MDA Life-Saving Fleet



Bright yellow MDA electric vehicles, E-Quadricycles, are now becoming a familiar sight on the streets of Israel.

Since its inception in 1930, Magen David Adom (MDA) has continually aimed to improve and expand its pre-hospitalization lifesaving care to the people of Israel. The objective of MDA is to be as close and as available as possible to each patient, thereby minimizing the time of arrival and treatment to the patient and significantly improving his/her chances for survival and recovery.

As part of its continued evolution, MDA is constantly looking to boost its first response fleet. Bright yellow MDA electric vehicles, E-Quadricycles, are now becoming a familiar sight on the streets of Israel. Newly-added to the emergency response



fleet of Mobile Intensive Care Units, ambulances, and emergency medical scooters, they allow for easy access and maneuverability because of their size. They are able to operate in all weather conditions, equipped with heating and air conditioning.

Said Eli Bin, MDA Director General, "We have found that these vehicles will significantly reduce MDA teams' response times and will become yet another important component that will help save lives." ■

Canadian Magen David Adom salutes Jon Dlusy who has generously donated a Mobile Intensive Care Unit (MICU) to the people of Israel in memory of his brother, Nathan Dlusy, and in memory of his parents, Regina and Israel Dlusy, who fled Nazi Germany.

In a moving and poignant dedication ceremony with family and friends, Jon, who was the younger brother, explained that Nathan, an RCAF Flight Sergeant, was killed during active service in 1944 at the age of 23. "This is a fitting gesture because Nathan, who had spoken of his intention to visit Israel, would have been so proud."

"I am grateful that I have been able to honor and do justice to my family's memories and, at the same time, provide Israel with the essential medical equipment needed to save lives," said Jon Dlusy. ■

Remembering Yudke Grossman

"I lost a lifelong friend in October when Yudke Grossman passed away," wrote Bernard Mendelman. Yudke grew up in Montreal and, in his teens, the YMHA on Mount Royal became his second home. He attended Baron Byng High School and received a degree in economics from McGill University.

In 1953 Yudke left Montreal to live in Israel at Kibbutz Galon and, in 1964, he married Nurit who had also made aliyah.

Yudke will best be remembered in Montreal for his efforts to bring teens to visit Israel through a variety of programs he established as a Jewish Agency emissary. He was also instrumental in creating

semester-abroad programs with various universities.

Although their home base was (and for Nurit, still is) Kibbutz

Galon, family and friends drew them back to Montreal for visits. A stop at Canadian Magen David Adom's (CMDA) office in Decarie Square was always included in their itinerary.

Nurit and Yudke were honored by their family, friends, and CMDA in August, 2009, with the dedication and presentation of a Mobile Intensive Care Unit to the people of Israel. Now stationed in Sderot, the MICU continues to enable first responders to fulfill their mission of saving lives.

Yudke's legacy and love of Israel will never be forgotten by all who were fortunate to know him and call him "friend". ■

Israel's Response to Mass Casualty Events

Daniel Amzallag, CMDA's National Media and Volunteer Coordinator, recently introduced Winnipeggers to the work of Magen David Adom at a presentation at the Rady Jewish Community Centre.

"Magen David Adom Israel is the world's most efficient medical service when it comes to responding to serious situations," said Daniel.

"In Israel, it takes the first responder on average less than a minute to reach the scene of an incident with the ambulance arriving in less than eight minutes. In Canada, the average time is 32 minutes."

Surprising to most was how Daniel defined mass casualty incidents. "It isn't the number of deaths and injuries that cause a situation to be labeled a mass casualty incident but rather whether or not there are enough ambulances, supplies and medical personnel to handle the situation," he said.

"It is not only in Israel that Magen David Adom saves lives and trains people in first aid," continued Daniel. "MDA goes into action world-wide when called upon and also trains first responders in a number of countries."

"It is a great feeling not only to be able to save lives but also to teach others how to save lives." ■

TOGETHER SAVING LIVES

Many came to acknowledge the evening's honouree **Sandy Galet**, a decades-long loyal supporter of Israel and MDA, who spoke passionately about *Magen David Adom* and the philanthropy through which she serves as an example to her family, children and grandchildren, all of whom share her generosity with love and admiration. Among those attending were **Eli Bin**, MDA Director General, **Israel's Deputy Consul Irit Stopper** and **Dr. Graham Sher**, CEO of Canadian Blood Services.

The keynote speaker, **Professor Eilat Shinar**, Director of Israel's Blood Services, emphasized the need for a safe and readily available supply of blood in Israel which, at the present time, is centralized in an unsafe, exposed 40-year old building that can neither serve the present growing population in Israel, nor withstand the threats of rocket attacks, cyber-attacks or anticipated natural disasters. spoke of the plan to develop and expand the present blood supply and storage system using the highest levels of technology which Israel has become known for. The new facility will be constructed to conform not only to current earthquake guidelines, but will incorporate two underground levels containing over 50,000 square feet of biologically filtered space, taking into account safety, security and accessibility.

A very moving and emotional video portraying the terrorist attack on 12 year old **Naor Ben-Ezra** who was stabbed two years ago in Jerusalem, left the audience gasping as the MDA Paramedic who

saved his life, **David Dalfen**, came up on stage to describe his actions as first on the scene. Without losing precious time, Paramedic Dalfen administered life-saving treatment and managed to get the boy with no pulse to the hospital in record speed, saving his life. Following the video, Naor and his parents were invited onto the stage and Naor's mother, **Ruthy**, said a few words of grateful appreciation in a choking voice.

The spectacular evening was enhanced by breathtaking performances by **Les Oiseaux du Paradis** and the fun and entertaining emcee **Joel Chasnoff**, whose humor and efficiency kept the evening going,

As of the end of September, 2017, the two blood mobiles, which went into service in September, 2015, have experienced a total of 28,000 blood donations.

The third successful Physicians' Mission to Israel took place in November. Led by Daniel Amzallag, CMDA's National Media and Volunteer Coordinator, doctors from across Canada travelled to Israel to take part in a week-long intensive learning experience with Magen David Adom paramedics and first responders.

Carolyne Elbaz always had a passion for medicine and, in the summer of 2010, travelled to Israel to volunteer in MDA's Yochai Porat MDA Overseas Program. "I can easily say it was the best summer of my life," she said.

Carolyne, now a hematology fellow from Montreal, took the opportunity to participate in the Mission and described her experience.

"On November 16, 2017, I flew to Israel with physicians of various specialties. The training was unlike anything I have ever been exposed to. The reality of paramedics and first responders is very different from the Canadian reality. Our exposure to field medicine, ACLS (Advance Cardiac Life Support), PHTLS (Pre-Hospital Trauma Life Support), working on MDA's MICU (Mobile Intensive Care Unit), as well as our contacts with leaders in the field were all very inspiring. The instructors and guest speakers made us feel welcome and took the time to convey their love for their country and their life-saving mission by teaching and showing us around different places in Israel."

She continued, "It gave me the opportunity to see Israel from a different perspective, a side I have never had the opportunity to see before. Travelling with doctors of various backgrounds made it particularly interesting and fun. Combining previous experiences with new skills allowed the group to bond quickly, especially during stressful drills."

Carolyne's feelings are shared by all those who have participated in this unique program.
