Magen David Adom: First on the scene

Beyond ambulances, Magen David Adom saves lives by providing superior training to EMTs (Emergency Medical Technicians) and by developing innovations like the new smart phone app and its "Life Guardian" Program.

The shrieks of terror grew louder as Lina Cooperman, a volunteer MDA EMT reached the esplanade in Jaffa. There, minutes earlier, a terrorist went on a rampage, stabbing anyone in his vicinity and leaving a trail of carnage in his wake. "It was chaos, absolute chaos," she said.

Anwar Srkaoui, another MDA volunteer, arrived within minutes of being dispatched to the Jaffa clock tower, slipping through Tel Aviv's notorious rush hour traffic on his well-equipped Emergency Medicycle.

The Jaffa attack killed one man and injured ten others. There were similar, albeit less deadly attacks that day in Jerusalem and Petah Tikvah, a stark reminder that no place in Israel is immune from violence in the current climate. These attacks are part of the wave of stabbings, car-rammings and shootings that have plagued Israelis since September 2015, killing more than 40 people and injuring 500.

While thwarting all these attacks is nearly impossible, responding to them is not. MDA, having developed world-renowned expertise in mass casualty

responses, has saved hundreds of lives. It has done this by embracing efficient and tech-savvy innovations.

In an effort to "see" the scene of an emergency and dispatch the most appropriate vehicles and personnel, MDA has up-graded its smart phone

app in order to provide a live video feed from the scene, adding another capability to what is already the most sophisticated phone app for summoning EMS help.

Users can mobilize MDA paramedics with one touch and enable dispatchers to see their exact location and the scene so that critical medical decisions can be made even as the paramedics are being dispatched.

"The app allows callers to obtain immediate help and provides dispatchers with critical information," said Eli Bin, MDA Director General. "It is all about providing a better and faster response and ensuring that we have the best equipment and the best-qualified



medics for a particular injury or ailment. Once they arrive, their training is what ultimately saves a person's life."

MDA is constantly refining and improving its training and protocols, making it a sought after authority in the medical community, frequently training other Red Cross societies and first responders from around the world. Emergency medical technicians who responded to the Boston Marathon bombing in 2013 cited their training with Magen David Adom a year earlier as instrumental in their rapid response.

MDA's cutting-edge training continues to save lives with its Life Guardian Program. This adds another layer of

responders by training and/or recertifying everyday Israeli citizens in CPR. Depending on their location, these Life Guardians receive notifications of an emergency on their mobile app and can rush to administer CPR or first aid until an MDA ambulance or medicycle arrives.

Donor support is critical because MDA does not receive Israeli government funding. Yoni Yagodovsky, MDA's Director of International Affairs, commented, "As Israel's only national emergency response organization, it is our responsibility to provide Israelis with the best, most professional treatment possible, and we can't offer that without the support from donors."

In this era of unpredictable and unprovoked attacks, the unique combination of innovatin, MDA training, and donor support is helping to keep Israelis alive. ■

In honour of the 90th Birthday of Mark Bernstein, the Zita and Mark Bernstein Family Foundation has donated an ambulance and a scooter to Magen David Adom. This generous gift was made in memory of Sara Bernstein, Mark's mother, who was the first National Chair of Magen David Adom in Canada under the Hadassah-WIZO umbrella.

"I come from a very strong Zionist family," said Mark. "For as long as I can remember, my mother was active with Hadassah-WIZO. What

I was not aware of until she passed away in 1986 was that she was also involved with Magen David Adom.

Asked why he chose to donate an ambulance and a scooter, he said, "because I can and I felt the need to do it. The survival of Israel is deeply engrained in me... Magen David Adom is an organization that saves lives."

"Learning of my mother's involvement gave me the push to make this donation in her memory...It is a gift to the people of Israel and the State of Israel. The survival of Israel and its people is a very important part of my life."

MDA International Physicians' Unit

NATIONAL



A group of 25 physicians from Canada and France recently spent a week in Israel taking part in the MDA "International Unit" - Advance Course. They attended lectures, courses and participated in trauma classes, Mobile Intensive Care Unit (MICU) shifts, and extreme drills throughout the south of Israel.

Leader of the Canadian group was Daniel Amzallag, CMDA's National Media and Volunteer Coordinator and himself a trained MDA Paramedic.

The course commenced with a conference at the Jerusalem Station, "MDA and Emergency Medical Innovations", and included topics on technological dispatch, instruction methods, how to utilize volunteers and medical innovations. An emotional personal story was shared by Michael Kosovski who was saved TWICE by the same Paramedic, Israel Weingarten. Michael sustained a cardiac arrest while playing baseball and, thanks to the MDA dispatcher who was able to instruct bystanders to perform CPR until the MDA team arrived, he survived.

Two years later, while in the gym, Michael went into yet another cardiac arrest and as fate would have it, the SAME paramedic was on call and saved his life again!

A Challenging Medical Championship was set up that included ten different medical emergency scenarios specifically arranged for the physicians. They dealt with a woman giving birth, a child suffering from heat stroke, a penetrating wound, even a tiger bite and more. This Championship could not have been the success it was without

the cooperation and assistance of our friends from MDA Negev Region, MDA's Paramedic School, Canadian Magen David Adom's representatives as well as our "Magen David Adom France" representative, Victor Wintz.

Time was also built into the program to allow for a climb up Masada and an emotional ceremony at the top of Masada in English, French and Hebrew with the picturesque sunrise in the background.



One event that was definitely not built into the program was an actual encounter with two severe car accidents on the way back to Jerusalem from Masada. The physicians were able to put their skills to work when they treated four people – two with life-threatening injuries, one with moderate injuries and one with mild injuries.
