MDA's 'First 7 Minutes' – Time Equals Life

On April 23, 2018 at precisely 8:26 pm Israel time (Toronto time 1:26 pm), an Emergency News Bulletin was announced on all Israeli news media channels dominating the usual 8:30 pm "breaking news" time slot.

"Deliberate fatal car ramming: at least 10 people hurt in a deliberate car ramming incident on one of Toronto's busiest streets in Canada."

This bulletin was announced in Israel, before local Toronto media had a chance to understand what was happening. Frantic calls started pouring in from MDA in Israel to local Magen David Adom's national and Toronto offices eager to find out more details.

As a result of this disastrous incident, MDA's International Division sent a team to Toronto for a special "First 7 Minutes" educational and training session which was originally developed with International physicians in Israel earlier in the year, fine tuned to the Toronto incident. Aimed at both Emergency Personnel as well as the general public, this special program focused on Mass Casualty Incidents methods

highlighting those crucial first minutes prior to the arrival of an Ambulance. While arrival times may vary from one city/country to another, the concept of intervention remains the same.

Emphasis was placed not only on the need for well-trained Paramedics, but also on training the public as to ways of getting involved and cooperating effectively with medical professionals in various forms of Mass-Casualty Incidents, regardless of one's medical background.

On average, MDA ambulances in Israel will arrive at the scene within "7 minutes". These "7 minutes" can feel like an eternity, unless those present know what first steps to take.

These "First 7 Minutes", when used effectively, can literally mean the difference between life and death, by utilizing basic tools and common-sense to ensure safety, rescue, basic first aid and accounting for the victims prior and post ambulance arrival. It emphasizes the concept of "altering" one's mindset from concentrating on one injured individual, to the mentality of "masses" while cooperating and following instructions of medical professionals.

The concept of Magen David Adom Israel's "First 7 Minutes" quickly spread throughout the International Community with MDA personnel delivering these guidelines to both public and national EMS worldwide. Countries that were never exposed to these fundamental strategies were empowered through proper training, counting on their own capabilities.

Much can be done by the public within those crucial "First 7 Minutes". Time is one of the most important factors in an emergency situation.

In every life threatening situation, the goal is to get the patient to hospital care as quickly as possible.

Rosh Hashanah...

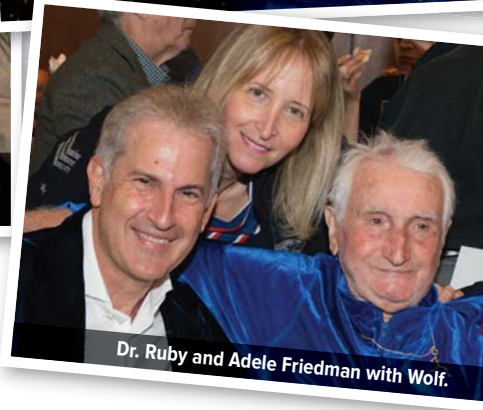

Guests included the Consul General of Israel, David

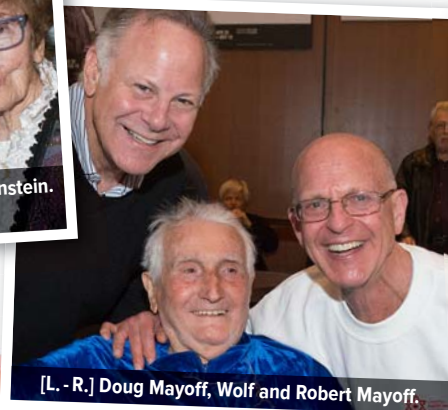

Saving Lives Here & Abroad

An AED (automatic external defibrillator) is a portable electronic device that can automatically diagnose and treat life-threatening cardiac arrhythmia by applying electricity which stops the arrhythmia, allowing the heart to re-establish an effective rhythm. With simple audio and visual commands, it is designed for use by a layperson.

Learning how and when to use AEDs was the subject of a presentation in May at the Jewish Social Services of Hamilton. Guest speakers were Dr. Eli Jaffe, MDA Deputy Director, Community Relations, Fundraising and International Relations, and Raphael Herbst, MDA Senior Paramedic and Canada Desk Representative, Fundraising and International Relations.

The presentation also reviewed first response in Israel and how to save a life in Hamilton.

Special thanks to Dr. Jason Ohayon who, himself, was a participant in both CMDA's first Physicians' Mission to Israel as well as in the advanced course, and to Daniel Amzallag, CMDA National Media & Volunteer Coordinator, for helping to arrange this event. ■

Israel is located on a very active fault line, resulting in the expectation of a massive earthquake (6 or higher on the Richter Scale) within the next 15 years, causing up to 70% damage to the country's infrastructure and the potential wounding of thousands.

As a result, the International Physicians' Unit was formed six years ago in order to train physicians world-wide, with the goal of having an "army of doctors" who would travel to Israel in the event of a disaster to assist with pre- and post-hospital procedures.

The one-week course includes theory and practical segments covering such fundamentals as Advanced Cardiovascular Life Support, Pre-hospital Trauma Life Support, and Mass Casualty Incidents.

The course would not be complete without a visit to Magen David Adom facilities and the opportunity to volunteer on a Mobile Intensive Care Unit.
