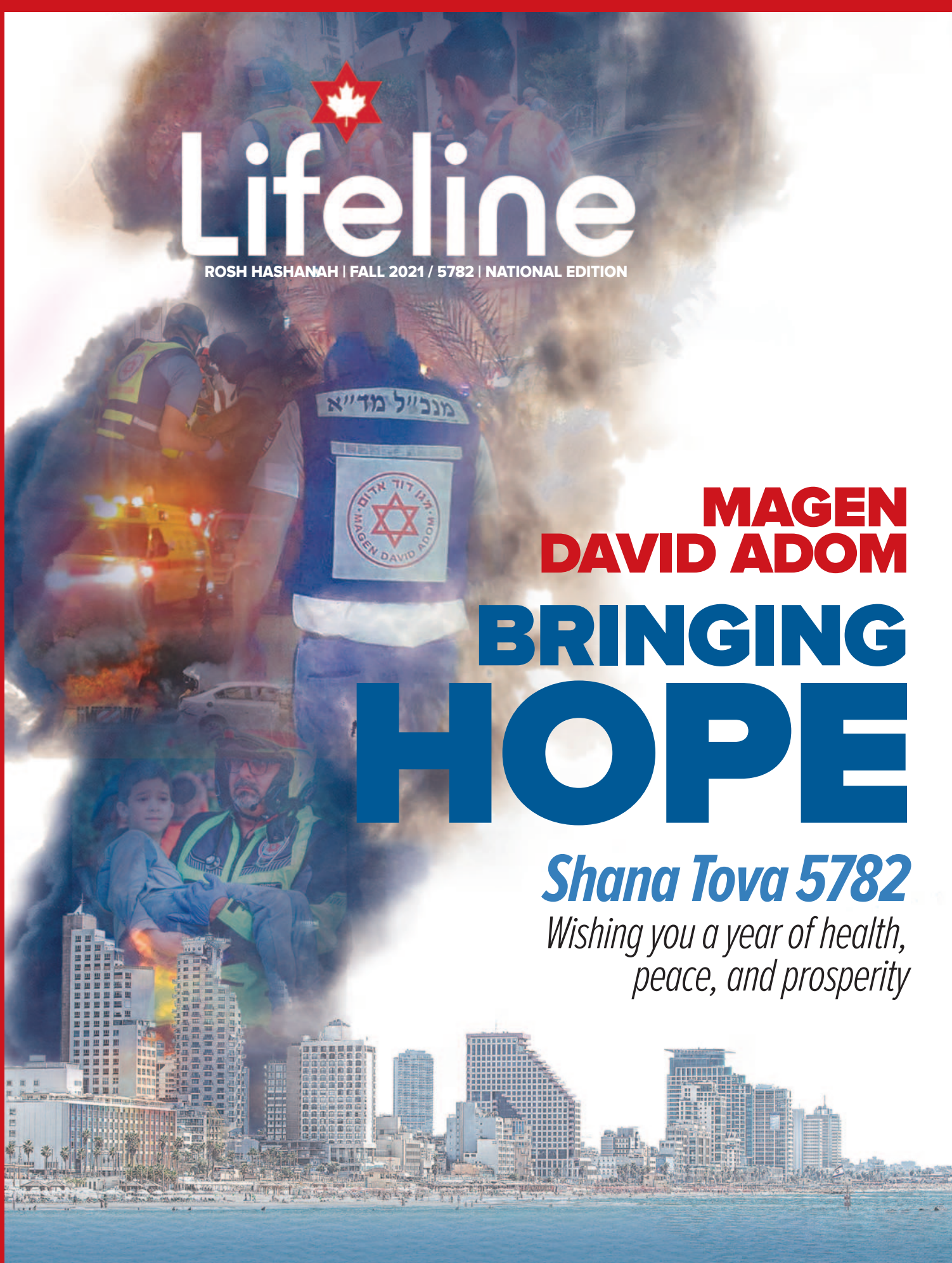

MDA Implements 'Resilience Program'

ISRAEL

The scope of the disaster was evident even before the dust had settled. What was supposed to be a Lag B'Omer celebration became a Multi-Casualty Incident with 45 deaths and more than 150 injured.

It became clear that the first responders and paramedics were facing an unprecedented event. With no time to think, they worked in an orderly, calm fashion, following protocol in order to treat the dying and injured. In the immediate aftermath, many were exhibiting signs of distress. Seeing the dead and the injured was causing great emotional stress. Reliving the event left them wondering if they could have done more.

"It's very difficult to get back to normal after such a disaster," said MDA paramedic, Yossi Halabi. "I speak to my team to make sure everyone is psychologically okay," he continued.

Conversations enable them to share their feelings during and after the event.

As a result, MDA has implemented the Resilience Program in an effort to respond to staff facing immediate and prolonged stress. Processing an event shortly after its occurrence and talking about it is essential in preserving and improving personal and team emotions.

MDA continues to monitor participants in the Mount Meron event.

Insights, Experiences & Passions

How the Magen David Adom Program in Israel Changed the Trajectory of Our Life Goals

TORONTO

My name is Lewis Orzech, born and raised in Toronto in a conservative, loving Jewish family with an upbringing that nurtured my goals and afforded me the options to explore my interests, seek out my own path and have the full support of family and friends.

I had known for several years that I had a growing passion to help people and wanted to bring my passion for physical and mental fitness together in a career that was personally fulfilling and also aided my community-at-large. I decided to choose science (my dad is a dentist).

I was starting my final undergraduate semester at the University of Ottawa with plans of going to Dental School. However, after talking at length with a good friend about ways to build my experience and gain insight, I remembered a camp counselor talking about the Magen David Adom program before he went to medical school.

My friend and I enrolled in the program in June 2018. On the first day of the program, we ran through a practical life-saving scenario and it was like a bolt out-of-the blue! Everything seemed to 'click'. I loved the collaborative effort of working with a team, I loved the fact that what I was doing was going to make a difference, and I loved the fact that it was physical/hands-on and, most importantly, having a direct impact on someone's actual life.

By day three I had two clear thoughts: One, I think I want to do this for the rest of my life and, two, If I decide to abandon becoming a dentist and transition to becoming a first responder, how

would I be judged by my friends and family who had an expectation of me becoming a 'stable professional' and not a first responder or firefighter? The only other time I had such clarity and assurance as it related to a potential career was on my first day of Fire Fighter Training at Seneca College in Toronto a year later.

After several long discussions with my uncle, who has always been a mentor to me, I decided that I didn't want to try to become a first responder, that I would be one. When I returned from my trip to Israel I was a changed person. I told my parents that I wanted to become a first responder and that I was going to take a year off to plan out the approach and invest all my energy in this pursuit.

Immediately, my MDA training paid a dividend because, within a few weeks of being home, I was recruited to be a Transfer Technician (transfer of non-ambulatory patients to various facilities) at a local provider. This was the direct result of my first aid training and experience in the program in Israel. While working patient transfer, I met a host of new colleagues and providers in different disciplines in emergency response and discussed with them my desire to become a firefighter or a paramedic. I realized that firefighting was the career I never knew I wanted. It was a perfect fit for my personality, strengths, and career/life goals.

I was accepted at Seneca College for firefighting. In December 2020, I graduated with my Firefighting pre-requisites. In May 2021, I took a summer position in northern Ontario in my first real firefighter role as an Ontario 'Fire Ranger'.

Today, as I embark on the adventure of a lifetime and the beginning of a journey that is so much more than a career, but speaks to the very essence of who I am, I am beyond excited! What started as a thought in 2018 in Jerusalem has now become a reality. I would like to continue to grow, learn and help people. Once my Fire Ranger contract ends and I return to Toronto, my plan is to become a first aid instructor, with hopes of returning to Israel to help MDA with their training.

My uncle once told me, "Find a career you love, and you'll never work a day in your life" and I truly understand that now.

Daniel Schwartz is a third year student at the University of Ottawa where he is pursuing an Honours Bachelor degree in Health Science. He is currently volunteering with the Magen David Adom Summer Student Program and, in his free time, he plays music with his friends and explores Tel Aviv, searching for the latest and greatest attractions.

"Magen David Adom's overseas volunteer program has exposed me to many opportunities. The program consisted of a 60-hour training course where I was able to learn Hebrew terminology that has allowed me to integrate into the culture that is Magen David Adom. I learned crucial skills such as CPR and basic post-trauma care.

But this was just the beginning. The course provided me with the confidence to enter the field and the actual fieldwork has been an extremely educational experience. I learned something new every day.

My goal this summer was to be in Israel, to contribute to the greater society. Magen David Adom has provided me with the platform to do just that. My experiences as a volunteer have been both enlightening and humbling. Being able to offer assistance to those in their most desperate times of need has been a transformational experience. These glimpses into the medical field have provided me with invaluable lifesaving skills that I will carry with me everywhere."

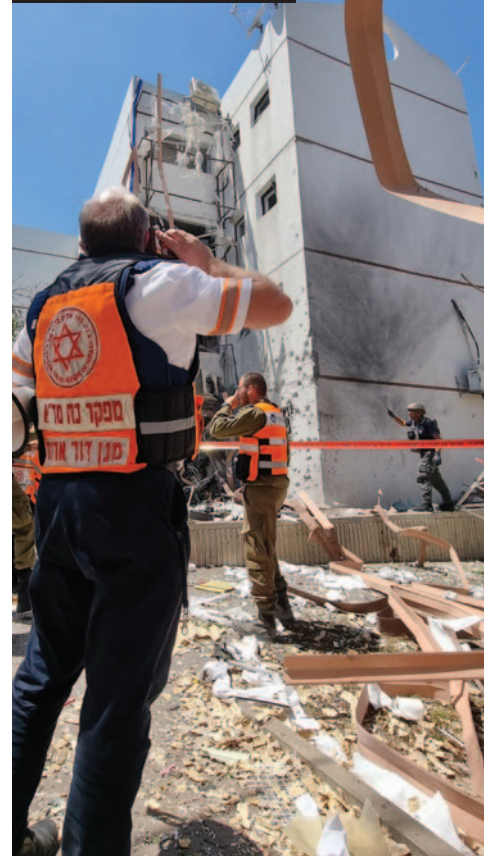

Martin has issued a challenge to other young professionals. “My dream is to see today’s volunteers become tomorrow’s donors and leaders.”



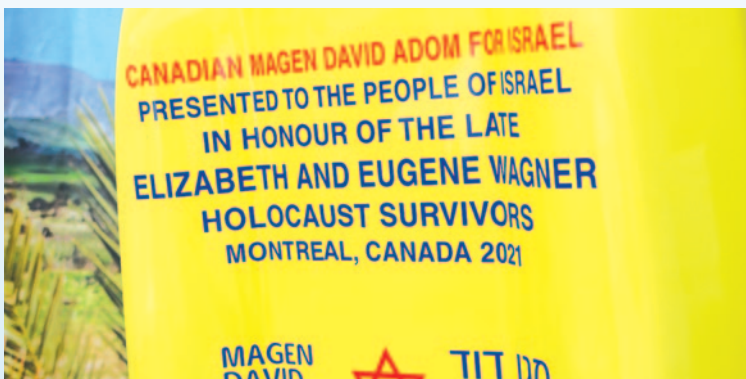
