# Saving Lives Beyond Israel's Borders







#### **UKRAINE**

As Israel's representative in the International Red Cross, Magen David Adom is doing everything it can to assist with the humanitarian crisis in Ukraine. MDA first responders are on the ground along the border to provide humanitarian aid and medical assistance to those who are in need. They are also assisting with providing shelter for refugees as well as sorting and allocating provisions.

MDA Israel has opened a registry for doctors and medical students living in and around Ukraine who wish to undergo a short period of training with MDA and the Red Cross and then volunteer on the ground. MDA has also opened a dedicated call centre within the MDA National Operations Center to aid Ukrainian refugees arriving in Israel.

As a proud member of the International Red Cross, MDA will continue to provide humanitarian aid wherever it can.



# Magen David Adom and Hatzalah

#### **ISRAEL**

Increased coordination between Magen David Adom and Hatzalah has resulted in a worldwide Jewish EMS network.

This relationship was best illustrated in June, 2021, when first responders and paramedics from Hatzalah South Florida raced to the scene of a condo collapse in Surfside, Florida. Although few of the EMTs had ever responded to a disaster of this nature, they were confident in their ability to provide treatment because they had been trained by Magen David Adom for just this type of scenario.

The relationship between MDA and U.S.-based Hatzalah organizations is mutually beneficial. MDA has provided American Hatzalah members



with training they are unable to receive in the States. And Hatzalah EMTs provide MDA with an auxiliary workforce when there are emergencies in Israel. It has also provided MDA with entrée into Orthodox communities.

"This is a huge asset to MDA and the Israeli people," said Uriel Goldberg, an MDA paramedic and instructor, who also serves as MDA's liaison with American Hatzalah organizations.

Yehiel Kalish, Chief Executive Officer of Chavra Hatzalah, the central coordinating group for Hatzalah in New York, said, "Given Magen David Adom's role in Israel and its level of expertise, working with their EMTs has afforded us advanced training and the ability to benefit from their many innovative protocols. And it has provided Hatzalah volunteers across the United States with the opportunity to forge a stronger connection with their fellow EMTs in Israel."

The relationship benefits both Magen David Adom and Hatzalah and has paid both organizations back in dividends many times over.

# MDA Ambulances Protected Against Viruses

In an effort to protect first responders, paramedics and patients against viruses, ambulances are being outfitted with easy-to-install air filters that transform the vehicles' air conditioning units into air purifiers.

The medical grade IN-EX filtration units, jointly developed by two Bar Ilan University scientists, have proven to be 99.15 percent effective against the coronavirus, influenza and other airborne viruses.

This innovative technology enables first responders to perform their duties in a safer environment and, at the same time, treat patients more effectively.





# Magen David Adom & Ben-Gurion University Announce Academic Affiliation

Magen David Adom (MDA) and Ben Gurion University of the Negev (BGU) have announced an academic affiliation designed to improve training for paramedics and emergency medical technicians, as well as improve the quality of pre-hospital emergency care in Israel and potentially around the world.

"Just as some of the most innovative and leading-edge medical centres are designated as teaching hospitals, we are officially making Magen David Adom a teaching EMS organization," said Eli Jaffe, MDA paramedic and Deputy Director for Community Health.

He continued, "The affiliation will enhance MDA's research abilities and expose the organization to a broader international audience through academic journals. MDA has experience in areas from which other EMS organizations can benefit – running a mass vaccination program, multi-casualty incidents."

Oren Wacht, head of Ben Gurion University's Department of Emergency Medicine and its Medical-Simulatiion Centre said, "This affiliation provides us with an opportunity to capitalize on a number of synergies between MDA and BGU. This includes coordinating activities between MDA's paramedic school and BGU's three-year bachelor's degree program in emergency medicine, as well as sharing experiences and instructors."

# Magen David Adom 91 years of saving lives

# 2021 IN NUMBERS

MDA celebrated 91 years; 30,000 employees, volunteers and National Service volunteers; 14,000 Youth Volunteers; 18,000 Life Guardians; 30,000 COVID-19 Ambassadors; 4.5 million volunteer hours provided by MDA volunteers; The oldest volunteer is 92.5 years old; The youngest volunteer is 14 years old; MDA activates a total of 189 stations and satellite stations; 17 new stations were opened during the last year; 2,000 ambulances and MICUs are stationed around Israel; 61 4x4 ambulances; 18 ATVs; 14 jeep-bulances; 24 MCRVs; 2 bus-bulances; 37 bulletproof MICUs and ambulances; 5 mobile light posts; 3 COVID- vaccination and testing caravans; 2 mobile MDA caravan stations; 525 Medi-Cycles; 34 intercity Medi-Cycles; 175 electric bicycles; 40 MERVs; 1 boat-bulance;

1,259,464 emergency callouts; MDA teams were dispatched every 25 seconds; 682,092 patients were treated by MDA teams; 44,023 of which were from motor vehicle collisions; 248 drowning patients were treated by MDA teams; 16,481 pregnant women were evacuated to the hospital; 972 babies were delivered by MDA teams; 350,000 people were trained in CPR and First Aid; 547 Youth Volunteers were trained in MCI response; 439 Youth Volunteers were trained as instructors; 269,023 units of blood were collected by MDA's Blood Services; 25% of blood donors are women; 19% of donors were first time blood donors; 27% of blood units were collected on IDF bases; MDA's Blood Services operate 46 blood mobiles; 2 blood mobile caravans; 5,409 units of plasma were collected from recovered COVID-19 patients; 3,800 units were given (in hospitals) to 1,900 corona patients in moderate and severe condition (2 per patient); MDA Human Milk Bank supplied 1,400 liters of human milk to infants in need in neonatal units; 155 new milk donors joined the project; 138 wishes were granted by the 2 Wish Ambulances; MDA operates 2 ALS helicopters; 330 patients were evacuated by the helicopters; 1 National Mobile Command Vehicle; 3 Regional Mobile Command Vehicles; MDA teams partook in 215 emergency preparedness drills; Over 2,717,174 calls were received in MDA's 101 Emergency Call Centers; A call was received on average every 11.5 seconds; The average time to answer a call is  $\frac{4}{3}$  seconds; MDA placed  $\frac{1,000}{3}$  AEDs in public areas in  $\frac{141}{3}$  communities around Israel;

The first of its kind, the Blood Centre will have an underground facility that can safely store Israel's blood supply – more than 500,000 units of blood -- and will include the most advanced equipment available today.

#### **TORONTO**




Family is very important to Ray as witnessed by his pride in his children, eight grandchildren, 17 great grandchildren, and his sister.

# An Interview With CMDA Supporter, Fanny Wedro

#### **CALGARY**

At 94 years young, Calgary resident, Fanny Wedro, is as active and outspoken as someone half her age. A Holocaust survivor, Fanny is a passionate advocate for and supporter of Canadian Magen David Adom.

CMDA Western Region Director, Sharon Fraiman, met with Fanny to talk about the importance of Magen David Adom and its lifesaving work.

Sharon: Fanny, how important is Magen

David Adom to the people of

Israel?

Fanny: How could Israel survive without it?

Magen David Adom is always first on the site of an accident, of an emergency. Magen David Adom is a necessity. It responds to the needs of the country. I have seen it many times. If an ambulance can't make it through the crowded streets, an emergency mediscooter can. The paramedic is able to treat the patient, often saving a life, until the ambulance arrives.

Sharon: MDA depends on the support of

donors.

Fanny: Yes. MDA is not supported by the Israeli government. It depends on the generosity of donors which is

why I believe so strongly in its

mission.

Sharon: Do you feel that people know

about Magen David Adom?

Fanny: Not enough people are aware of MDA and what it does. I first

learned about MDA in 2006 during the war with Lebanon. I was watching the news and saw a building on fire in Israel. An MDA ambulance was guickly on the

scene but, unfortunately, it was

destroyed.

My friends and I felt we had to do everything possible to replace that ambulance. Within a month, we had received enough donations to do just that. The Calgary community has been very supportive, having donated ambulances, emergency medical scooters, incubators, and essential medical equipment and supplies.

Sharon: At 94, you feel that it is important to continue your efforts on behalf of MDA?

Fanny: At my age, I do what I can. Magen David Adom saves lives — every day when every second is critical. I thank Magen David Adom, its paramedics and first responders. I thank all those who support the lifesaving efforts of MDA and I encourage others to do the same.
