Over 150 Volunteers Save Lives with MDA

Magen David Adom's (MDA) Overseas Volunteer Program recently held its annual ceremony on Thursday, with 158 foreign volunteers in attendance, half of whom had completed the June program, and the rest about to begin their ambulance shifts.

After ten days of extensive training, the volunteers are deployed on ambulances and provide support – both physical and emotional – to their patients.

Canadian volunteer Eva Mamane had felt that while it could sometimes be easy to dismiss a situation as non-life-threatening, she came to realize how important every single call was, including the time she had to carry a man from his chair to his bed. Maman added that the program taught her a number of critical skills, including how to take a patient's blood pressure at 100 km/h.

"Through the program, we were provided with priceless opportunities to save lives on a daily basis," said Eva.

In late July, Israelis in southern cities were rushing to bomb shelters as rockets were launched by terrorist groups from the Gaza strip. During this time, a 41-year-old man was stabbed in a terrorist attack aboard a bus near Ramot.

Then, on August 7, a conflict broke out as the IDF was attempting to neutralize threats from Islamic Jihad in Gaza. Over the course of the three-day conflict, MDA teams were on high alert and treated 47 patients, including 3 injured by shrapnel, 31 injured while running to secure locations, and 13 with stress symptoms, including a 74-year-old female who was sedated and conveyed to Asuta Hospital in Ashdod.

MDA treated several more patients with minor injuries who were hurt while making their way to secure rooms but did not require to be conveyed to hospital, and several patients with stress symptoms who were treated on scene.



During the conflict, one Israeli refused to adhere to the red alert sirens as hundreds of rockets were being launched into his hometown of Ashkelon. Baby Boy Greenberg was ready to come into this world, and nothing was going to stop him. With the help of MDA teams who arrived in record time, the baby boy was delivered into safe and loving arms in a time of conflict.

Terror attacks continued to escalate in Israel, even after a ceasefire was reached. MDA treated and evacuated seven people following a terror attack in the Old City of Jerusalem on August 13. Two of them were in serious condition, including a pregnant woman who gave birth at the hospital.

MDA Senior EMT Nehemia Katz and MDA Paramedic David Trachtenberg recall, "We were on scene very quickly. On Ma'ale Hashalom Street,

we saw a passenger bus at a standstill in the middle of the road. Bystanders called us to treat two males who were on the bus with gunshot wounds. They were fully conscious and walking with wounds to the upper body. We provided them with lifesaving treatment and transported them to hospital. From there, we went to the King David's Tomb parking area and found four males, one aged 50 and three aged 30, all fully conscious with gunshot wounds.

A few moments later, the MDA ATV brought us another victim, a woman in her 30s with gunshot wounds. We provided lifesaving treatment to the victims and conveyed them urgently to hospital, with two in serious condition and five in mild to moderate condition."

Advanced Life Support Boat Donated by CMDA Supporters Leonard and Faigel Shapiro is Making Waves



Saving Lives in The Sea of Galilee

CALGARY

Leonard and Faigel Shapiro's generous support for Canadian Magen David Adom over many years, has helped save countless lives. The Shapiros have donated standard ambulances, advanced life support vehicles and emergency mediscoters that are in service throughout Israel. And now, their latest gift is helping to protect and save lives on the waters of the Sea of Galilee.

"This is another wonderful gift from the Shapiros to the people of Israel," said Sharon Fraiman, Western Region Director for CMDA. "We are so thankful for their on-going support for CMDA."

The Shapiros recently donated a \$240,000 Advanced Life Support Boat that is on-call to respond to emergencies on the beaches and communities on Lake Kinneret (Sea of Galilee) in Tiberias. It's one of the world's most advanced emergency re-

sponse vessels. Equipped with two powerful outboard motors and with a speed of 35 knots, regardless of conditions, the boat can reach most incident scenes in eight minutes or less. It can carry up to 1,000 kg. (2,205 lbs.), as well as eight crew members and/or patients.

In just the first month in operation, it successfully responded to many calls including one for a two-month-old baby who was burned by hot water at the beach and a 12-year-old boy who became dehydrated during a cruise and lost consciousness, hitting his head on the pier.

"Faigel and I are gratified that the boat is having such a significant impact on MDA's ability to respond to emergencies on the water," said Mr. Shapiro. "It has quickly become a vital piece of equipment and is already saving lives."

The boat is equipped with advanced life support medical tools including a defibrillator, respirator and vital signs monitors and is staffed by a spe-

cially trained team of MDA paramedics and EMTs. Its unique design gives the boat the ability to moor close to the shore, and the bow opens to allow responders to easily load patients from both in the water and on the beaches. It's a real game-changer in MDA's ability to respond to water emergencies.

The new Advanced Life Support Boat will be stationed at Lido Beach in Tiberias. The central location provides quick access to all the beaches and allows the crew to assist in road accidents on two major highways that run along the lake.

"MDA's Advanced Life Support Boat will allow us to significantly improve our capabilities and reach all patients," said Eli Bin, MDA Director General. "I thank our dear donors from Canada, Leonard and Faigel Shapiro and their families, for making this possible."

Ida and Saul Alpern Donate a Second Mobile Intensive Care Unit

In October, 2020, journalist Myron Love wrote about a donation made by Winnipeggers Saul and Ida Alpern to Canadian Magen David Adom. Back then, the Alperns had donated \$160,000 for the purchase of a Mobile Intensive Care Unit (MICU) for Israel's national EMS Magen David Adom (MDA).

The MICU was donated to the people of Israel in memory of Saul Alpern's parents and siblings who perished in the Holocaust. "It is an expression of my love for my family and my love of Israel," said Saul Alpern. Ida Alpern explained that the MICU they donated in 2020 was built in Quebec and was put into action in Israel in March 2021. In an activity report sent to the Alperns by CMDA, the MICU stationed in Tiberias responded to a total of 877 emergency calls.



Now, in a further expression of generosity, the Alperns have donated \$170,000 toward the purchase of a 4x4 Life-Support Ambulance.

The addition of this specialized ambulance to MDA's emergency vehicle fleet will enhance response capabilities and help save lives every day.

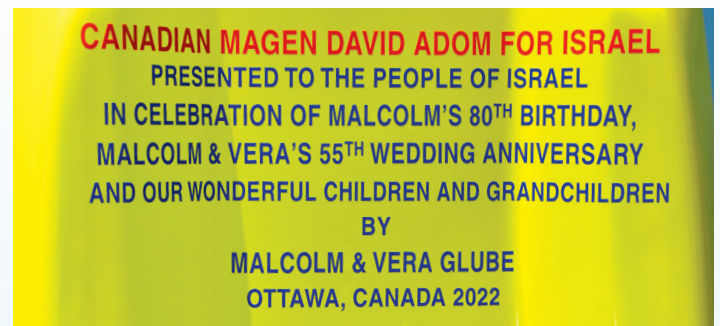
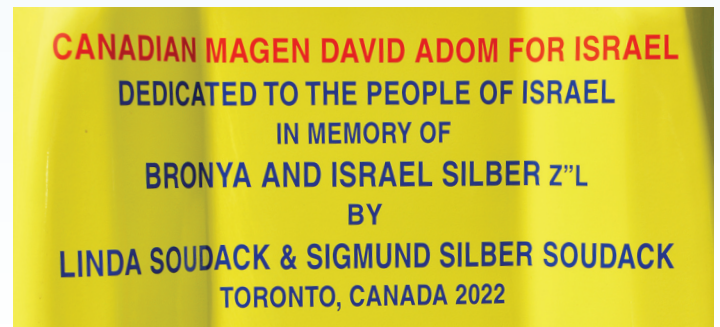
