New Airborne Intensive Care Units Will Change Survival Rates Drastically



ISRAEL

Magen David Adom has been operating an Advanced Medical Air Ambulance in Israel for sixteen years. As part of a new partnership between Magen David Adom, Brook Aviation and Hatzolah Aviation Division, two new advanced helicopters have started operation, crewed by MDA flight paramedics. The helicopters allow MDA medical teams to arrive at remote locations with advanced medical equipment; locations otherwise unreachable by

more conventional vehicles. Just three weeks ago, MDA teams saved the lives of a passenger in a light aircraft that crashed in the Galilee, and using one of the new helicopters, assisted rescue teams and the fire department to reach the scene.

The new Sikorsky 76 helicopters are staffed by some thirty experienced MDA flight paramedics, and the helicopters are larger, stronger and faster. The helicopters, that operate 24 hours a day all year round, allow easier and faster treatment for two critically injured patients simultaneously. The helicopters can reach speeds of 287 km/h and have an increased range of 761 kilometres.



They are able to land anywhere including roads, open spaces, mountainous and rocky areas, and are equipped with advanced medical equipment, including resuscitation devices, ventilators, medicine and more.

Since beginning operation in March 2023, MDA teams have saved dozens of lives in the new helicopters, including a 12-year-old injured in an ATV accident with a severe head injury, as well as a 57-year-old who suffered a cardiac arrest in the Arava and within minutes, was conveyed to the cardiac catheterization lab.

Brook Aviation CEO, Gil Peleg: "Brook Aviation is an Israeli helicopter company. Our role as a flight company is to provide the flight elements and to ensure that we can raise MDA's excellent paramedics, bring them to the scene in the fastest and safest way possible, and provide the best medical care for the patients during the evacuation to hospital."

Magen David Adom is currently in need of two additional helicopters to complete this fleet and ensure rapid response times, no matter the national security alert level.

MDA Desperately Needs 300 New Ambulances



ISRAEL

Magen David Adom is in desperate need of 300 new ambulances. With the ongoing threat of terrorist attacks, the likelihood of a destructive earthquake in the near future, and the imminent danger of a multi-front military conflict in the north and with other terrorist organizations in the West Bank and Gaza, an adequate fleet of ambulances has never been more vital. When MDA engages an MCI protocol in the event of such multi-casualty scenarios, it can sometimes deploy hundreds of ambulances to a single location. This can leave other areas of the country lacking proper emergency response. With the addition of 300 ambulances to the national fleet, MDA will have to tools to respond to all emergencies in any scenario. Each ambulance saves hundreds of lives each year.

Fanny Wedro z'l Honoured by University of Calgary

"Don't think that standing here before you is a 95-year-old woman. In front of you is a 14-year-old girl whose life was taken away, who was left with no parents, no grandparents, no relatives, no one. Yet I had to go out into the world. And let me tell you...it's a wonderful world!"

These were the opening words of an address by Holocaust survivor, Fania (Fanny) Wedro, to the University of Calgary graduating class of 2023. The lucky 1200-strong audience comprised of university leadership, honorees, students, parents and friends, listened in pin-drop silence to the beautiful and wise woman at the microphone. Fania delivered an 8-minute speech to inspire the graduating students to not only "spread light into the world" but to "cherish and respect their country". A long-standing ovation followed. Ten minutes prior, the jam-packed Jack Simpson Gymnasium watched as the University of Calgary Chancellor, John Cornish, awarded Fania Wedro with an Honorary Doctorate Degree of Laws.

She was only 14 years old in Koretz, Ukraine/Poland, when the Nazis and their collaborators shot her mother along with most of the 5000-strong Jewish population of that town, quickly burying them in mass graves. "She's 16!", her mother fibbed just before her imminent death when a Nazi officer inquired about Fania's age. This was Chaya Elman's last attempt to save her



daughter and it worked; Fania was selected for manual labor to shovel dirt over the mass graves where her own mother's body lay lifeless. In months and years to come, Fania managed to escape a fire-engulfed ghetto, took refuge in empty graves, and hid in a forest, cold and sick with no food or water.

Immigrating to Edmonton in 1948 as a domestic servant, Fania worked as a maid for a number of years. She married and raised two children. With her husband, fellow Holocaust survivor, Leo Wedro z'l, Fania went on to own drug stores and eventually, the Cascade Inn in the city of Banff. Together with her beloved Leo, Fania became a notable builder of Alberta, taking immense pride in contributing to and driving various Canadian projects and causes. The couple became one of Western Canada's leading entrepreneurs and established the Wedro Holocaust Foundation in Calgary.

Fania Wedro funded the efforts of Father Patrick Desbois (France) in

uncovering mass graves, where roughly 1.8 million Ukrainian/Polish Jews anonymously fell to their death by Nazi bullets. Fania was a keynote speaker at the annual Holocaust Symposiums at Mount Royal University for more than 41 years. She was also a founding member and philanthropist behind Magen David Adom Canada (Calgary Chapter), raising funds for Israel's only blood bank and emergency services.

As a natural leader and a tireless Holocaust educator, Fania led multiple groups of high school students and adults on "March of The Living" missions through Europe's death camps. She last led the mission when she was 86 years young.

In awarding Fania Wedro the Honorary Doctorate Degree in Laws, the President of the University of Calgary, Dr. Ed McCauley, thanked Fania for her dedication in promoting Holocaust education. "A leading philanthropist and speaker, Fania gave back to the community with a lifetime of

volunteerism, speaking to schools, community groups and government officials about her horrific Holocaust experiences.", he remarked. Fania Wedro, who spoke seven languages fluently, quoted Pushkin poetry perfectly, and offered encyclopedic insights into Judaism, history and current events. Busy dodging bullets and camp deportations to survive one of the greatest tragedies in human history, at 95, she finally received the honour long overdue. Dr. Fania Wedro was nominated to receive the honorary doctorate by two independent entries - the first in the history of University of Calgary. With her usual humility, Fania commented, "I don't know what I did to deserve this."

CMDA and the entire Magen David Adom family mourn the loss of our dear friend Dr. Fania Wedro. Fanny lived a life of resilience, purpose, contribution, and devotion to Holocaust education. Her unwavering commitment to Israel and Jewish causes all over will remain etched in our memories. Fanny, you will be dearly missed.

Recently, FOI has been directly involved in transporting civilians to safety in the Russia/Ukraine conflict. In addition, FOI has raised money for bomb shelters in Israel, ambulances, medi-cycles, defibrillator stations and more.

In Canada, FOI works closely with CMDA’s Western Region Director, Sharon Fraiman, in order to help with CMDA’s major fundraising events in Calgary, Alberta, and Winnipeg, Manitoba.

Jeff Shaw, a Representative of Friends of Israel Gospel Ministry Canada, and Sharon Fraiman are pleased to collaborate again and announce an upcoming “Honour Israel Night” in Calgary on Thursday, November 2nd at 7:00 PM, at the Carriage House Hotel & Conference Centre (9030 MacLeod Trail South). The evening is being hosted by the FOI Canada in order to help raise funds for important medical equipment needed in Israel.

Because of wars and repeated terrorist attacks, Magen David Adom has emerged as a world leader in emergency medical services, and is the most experienced mass-casualty response organization on the planet – made up of mainly tens of thousands of tireless volunteers.

Unlike similar medical organizations, MDA is not publicly funded, and needs our help to raise the money needed to provide the hundreds of ambulances (ten of which were donated to the Ukrainian people to help with local medical response), medi-cycles, and other important equipment needed in the ongoing efforts to save lives.

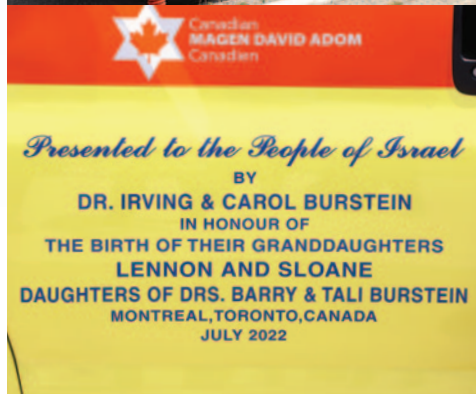
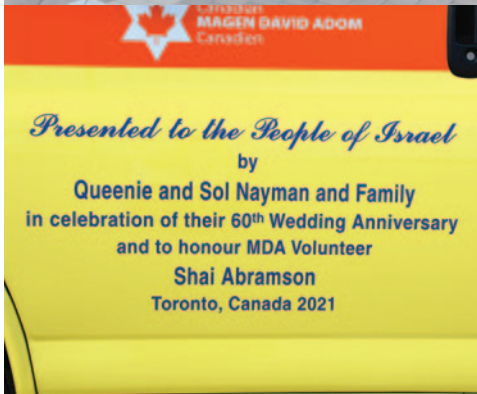
